



## Student-Led Facilitation Workshop

*Student-led IEP meetings increase positive student outcomes as well as communication and collaboration between the school district and family. Because of this, more and more school districts are requesting professional development to help support student-led IEP meetings.*

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As part of our Facilitated IEP professional development services, Key2Ed has developed the Co-Facilitation for Student-Led IEP Meeting workshop.

It provides instruction to IEP facilitators in successfully preparing students to co-facilitate their own IEP meetings. The workshop is designed to teach how to set-up, conduct and have follow through with the student being a co-facilitator in the process. Participants will be prepared to deploy skills learned and practiced through the training the very next day. This workshop delivers:

- Review of core facilitation skills
- Role plays using co-facilitation strategies
- Focus on student empowerment and engagement in their IEP meeting

This one-day training is for participants who have completed the initial FIEP workshop and have implemented the Key2ed facilitation model in their IEP meetings.
